## TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

The tournament will be played in accordance with Scottish Hockey rules under FIH guidelines

- Arrival at the tournament from 0800 hours. Please arrive changed although changing rooms will be available on the day
- Teams should report to the desk on arrival to collect information
- The first game for BOTH TOURNAMENTS is 0830 hours. WE MUST BE FINISHED FOR 1700 HOURS SO IF TIME IS RUNNING OUT THEN THE CROSS OVER GAMES WILL BE REDUCED IN TIME.
- PLEASE NOTE THERE ARE NO RUNNING PENALTIES IF THERE IS A DRAW AT THE END OF THE 3rd TO 8th PLAY OFF GAMES. RUNNING PENALTIES WILL TAKE PLACE BUT ONLY IN THE FINAL DUE TO TIME RESTRAINTS.
- For the boys tournament we welcome 6 teams and the girls 8 teams. For the boys tournament we will play a round robin event and a FINAL. At the Girls tournament we will play over 2 sections with cross over games for final placings and the last game is the FINAL.
- Both tournaments will be 10 minutes each way 2 minutes half time and 5 minutes warm up.
- Central timing will be in place for all games and please bring an umpire to officiate. The club/school umpire won't be asked to umpire their own game.
- Warm up and match balls will be provided on the day. Please do not bring your club/school balls on the day.
- Penalty Corners – all defenders on the opposite side to the pull pusher. Normal rules apply for all ages.
- Masks to be worn for defending corners (all behind the line)
- Maximum teams of 12 players are permitted
- First named team will have the ball to start and second named team will choose their defending end
- 3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw and 0 points for a loss.
- The final for the girls and boys is 10 minutes each way with a 2 minute half time
- If there is a tie for points at the end of the tournament in order to establish final placings the following applies: **1. Goal difference 2. Goals scored 3. Goals against**
- The result between the two teams
- Running penalty competition (3 takers then sudden death with same takers. If no result then we go through the team until there is a winner)
- Timing – 8 seconds for each running penalty We have a "player of the tournament" so we will be asking coaches for their player name from the opposition at the end of each game




